

Meadow Flower Mixture

20 types of seeds are represented in each sachet to give your garden a truly varied appeal. This meadow flower mixture includes annuals and perennials which give colour for the first year or flowering annually in turn throughout six months of the year.

Sow between April and November.

Sow rate of 2g bag

Coverage = 1 square Metre.



Sowing in pots or trays

If you want to start your seedlings in trays, modules or small pots (*many can be sown direct in the garden*), you will need compost, peat free seed compost is best, but you need a good quality one ask your local garden centre to recommend a good brand for seed sowing.

Sowing Wildflower Seeds

Sow wild flower garden seeds between April and November, they prefer an open position in full sun.

For annual displays, autumn sowing favours wild red poppy seeds and cornflowers, whereas spring sowing tends to favour corn cockles and corn marigolds.
